#### Standard lens enhancements

#### · Solid tints and dyes

They're practical, as well as fashionable. Tints and dyes can help reduce the amount of light that can enter the eyes through the lenses.

#### Plastic gradient dyes

This treatment creates an effect where lenses are darker at the top and gradually lighten toward the bottom.

#### · Scratch-resistant coating

This is a film or coating that protects plastic lenses from scratching and pitting — leading to longer lasting, clearer lenses.

#### Anti-reflective coating

This lens treatment helps prevent distracting glare and eye fatigue. It reduces the amount of light reflecting off the lens surface, meaning the lenses appear clearer — and making the eyes behind them more visible, too.

#### Ultraviolet (UV) protection

Ultraviolet treatments are built into and applied to lenses as a coating. Designed to help filter out harmful rays, this process helps block 98%–100% of transmitted and reflected UVA and UVB rays.

#### Polycarbonate lenses

The lens material is thinner, lighter, and harder to break than standard plastic. We make these the standard lenses for children's eyewear, so they can keep up with active kids. Plus, they provide UV protection and are scratch resistant.

#### · Photochromic lenses

These lenses are great for convenience and style. They darken when exposed to sunlight and lighten when away from it.

#### • Progressive lenses

These are a great alternative to juggling different pairs of glasses. These bifocal or multifocal lenses have no visible lines where the lens power gradually changes from distance to near.
